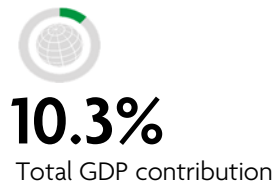


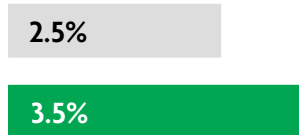

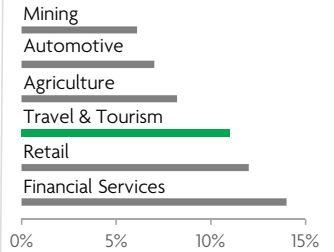
While the global economy grew by 2.5%,

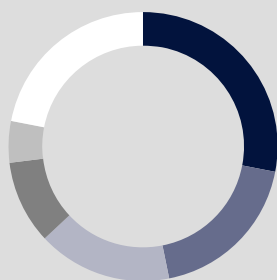

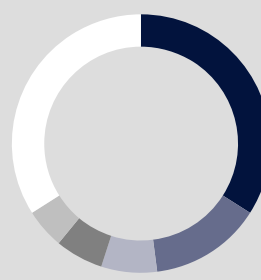

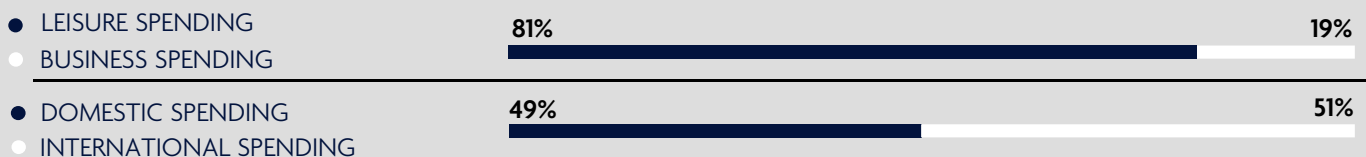
